- The Local Control Funding Formula, the state's new school finance system, is three years old. Parents should be actively involved in developing the Local Control and Accountability Plan, but a couple of surveys have shown that most parents aren't even aware of the LCFF or the LCAP. What are we going to do about that in our PTA?
- The last day to register for the November election is October 24. It's not too late to encourage high school seniors and parents to register to vote.
- Registration is open for Sacramento Safari, which will take place on February 27 and 28. Are we sending someone from our PTA?
- The Communicator has an interesting article about the Brown Act, which ensures that school board members and other elected officials don't make decisions in secret.
